As we come out of lock down the number of visitors to Findhorn has increased, it is great to see the Village and businesses busy. As the government is always saying 'during these unprecedented times' we want to reassure you that we are working to manage this increase in volume, particularly around cars, motorhomes and 'wild camping'.


We are working with Moray Council to progress the change of use planning application for motor home stop over at the West Beach Car Park, this is ongoing. In the meantime, Moray Council has advised that we can allow stop over for motor homes in this area. The toilet block is now open and TFVCC has provided additional rubbish points in the West Beach Car Park. This area is monitored throughout the day, especially to ensure we have adequate litter provision.

We have had several issues with visitors camping in dunes and beach areas. Unfortunately, under the Land Reform (Scotland) Act 2003, we cannot tell them not to or stop them pitching their tents. However, they cannot take motorised vehicles onto the dunes/beach. If you witness anyone who is causing damage or litter or fouling, we ask that you call the Police. As I am sure you will appreciate it is not always prudent to approach people who you do not know so please do not challenge.

We have identified an area near the toilet block at the West Beach Car Park that we are going to sign post for tents. We hope that our visitors will comply and follow the Scottish Outdoor Code.

We continue to work to make improvements in the Village for the benefit of residents and visitors and we thank you for your continued support
